



PARTNERSHIP COMMITMENT:

To support improvements in Aboriginal health outcomes through linkage with Environmental Health Services

As a KAHPF member, you are invited to sign this Partnership Commitment to strengthen your service's partnership with Environmental Health Service Providers in the region.

In KAHPF's own *Strategic Plan 2018-2028*, members assert '*...a particular focus on high quality, culturally responsive primary health care that considers the impact of social determinants on health outcomes including environmental health*'.

The first of 21 agreed regional indicators for the KAHPF Strategic Plan monitors the proportion of presentations in primary health care (PHC) directly attributable to the environment using Kimberley Environmental Attributable Fractions (KEAFs). Over 40 diseases have a measured environmental attribution in the Region. In 2016, 20% of hospitalisations of Aboriginal people in the Kimberley were directly attributable to the environment.

This partnership commitment aims to improve public health outcomes through increased environmental health action, through support provided to families and at the community level. The Kimberley Environmental Health Referral pathway promotes uptake of referral service by strengthening local health partnership, providing consistency and increasing shared knowledge.

By signing this Partnership Commitment, you agree to:

- Orientation of staff to ensure knowledge and skills to initiate an Environmental Health referral, particularly incoming clinical staff
- Support data-driven planning between PHC and EHSP
- Support your staff to participate in a minimum agreed number of formal, local partnership meetings at each participating site (between PHC and EHSP)
- Encourage participation of your staff, PHC & EHS in collaborative activities (with relevant community governance) including 'health days' or other health promotion
- Support case conferencing focussed on benefit for the patient and family
- Audit adherence to these commitments at least annually
- Provide feedback to KAHPF Environmental Health SubCommittee for continuing development of partnerships between health services and environmental health.

This Partnership Commitment will be reviewed again no later than mid-2022 as part of the evaluation of the KAHPF Strategic Plan.
